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## **BIBLE & ME – BOOK OF MORMON & ME**

### **Study Aid Introduction**

“The Race” (for families) and “Team Challenge” (for groups) are enjoyable activities, or tools, for personal, family and group study of the Bible and Book of Mormon. When we consider these activities study aids instead of games, reverence for God’s Word can be preserved. One of the purposes of these activities is to encourage members to engage in more in-depth search of the scriptures. Another purpose is to acquaint people with the wording and spirit of God’s Word. By reading directly from the scriptures instead of from a story book, participants get a fuller sense of the beauty and spirit of the scripture.

For most people, the first experience with the scriptures is in learning the stories, so for a broader range of interest, and for brevity sake, story references are broken up, many times skipping verses. Some verses of scripture don’t carry the story line. Participants should, for spiritual edification, be encouraged on their own to read the whole selection directly from the scripture.

#### **“THE RACE” (For Families) and “TEAM CHALLENGE, (For Groups)”**

How these activities encourage the following principles:

- **PRINCIPLE # 1: To do personal study of scripture stories in-depth, and in an enjoyable way.**  
 Why? Because we learn by asking questions; We can learn by searching; We can learn from others; And we can learn to work together in families and in the “body of Christ.”  
 How? By use of questions and answers; By personal study and writing questions; And by competitive interaction with others.
  
- **PRINCIPLE #2: To read directly from God’s Word instead of a story book.**  
 Why? To become familiar with the spirit and language in which it is written, also to get important details from the reading.  
 How? By reading just the stories of the scripture.
  
- **PRINCIPLE # 3: To experience reward for effort**  
 Why? Because in working toward a goal we are driven by our desire for the reward. God gives us rewards in blessings and miracles in our “race” for eternal salvation, the ultimate reward.  
 How? By points gained from questions *and* answers to finish a personal “race” with the family group, and get a prize; And in the “Team Challenge,” by team work in competition with other teams.
  
- **PRINCIPLE #4: To Work with just the scripture stories**  
 Why? To shorten the selection for interest sake as well as in the interest of time. Our first experience with the scripture is usually the stories. Because the target of these study activities is directed to a broad range of ages and interest they are confined to the scripture stories. People should be encouraged to read all the verses for spiritual edification).  
 How? By skipping verses of admonition, to stick to the story line.

## **“THE RACE”**

(For personal study & Family Challenge). Each participant needs both scriptures, paper & pencil; A spinner (store bought or homemade [page 42]); timer

- **Copy the Score Sheet on page 36 & place each participating family member down the left column for their personal “race”, and continue repeating names in the same order down the sheet. Even non-reading young ones can get the gist of a story when read directly from the scripture. They should be able to participate with help as long as they are able to understand.**
- **The goal for each personal race is 50 points or whatever the family decides. Points are earned by making and answering questions (see scoring, page 38).**
- **Each participant runs his “Race,” not in competition with other participants, but for his reward.**
- **The family chooses from the Scripture Reference Guides (pages 7-32) a Bible & a Book of Mormon story for all participants to read on their own for the weekly (or however often decided by the family) “Family Challenge.”**

### **For all family participants (For personal study)**

1. Sign the Participant Agreement (page 37).
2. Read the stories chosen by the family from the Story Reference Guides in the week the stories are assigned (Young non-readers can choose a helper, who gets 1 point for each time they help).
3. Write as many questions as you can, each starting with a Question Word (Who, What, Why, When, Where, How). Each question made earns 1 point.
4. Take your questions to another participant. They will ask you your own questions. You get 1 point for each question you make and 1 point for each right answer.
5. Bonus Question option: After all of your questions are asked & answered, you are given the option to answer a Bonus Question. There is a risk if you choose this option (pages 3 & 38).
6. The one asking your own questions to you records your total points for questions, answers, & Bonus Question, if you have chosen, and entered by your name on the Master Score Sheet. See scoring, pages 3 & 38.
7. When you reach the set goal for that “race” (50 points or whatever is decided) you are given the prize you yourself have requested, decided at the beginning of each “race,” & at the approval of the family. Then another “race is begun.”
8. The person can go fast or slow. Slow is reading just the 2 stories chosen weekly for the “Family Challenge.” Fast is reading sets of stories and making questions about them, one after the other until they reach the goal of 50 points, one set at a time. This is one race. Then they start over to work on winning another race of 50 points.

## **“FAMILY CHALLENGE”**

**OVERVIEW** (See page 4 for full directions)

1. The family chooses a day, time & one story from the Bible & one from the Book of Mormon for the weekly “Family Challenge” (see Story Reference Guides,” pages 7-32).
2. Family gathers at appointed day & time and chooses a Score Keeper (page 6, #4).
3. Participants are given 5 minutes to write as many questions as they can on their own, each starting with a Question Word (pages 39-41).
4. Each one, in turn, asks a question. Anyone can say, “I have it!” to answer. There can be 1 challenge for the point.
5. Bonus Question option: After all questions are asked and answered, each participant is offered the option of answering a question from the Bonus Question Help Guides (pages 23 & 34) and taking the risk of losing points if the answer is wrong. They spin the spinner from points gained or lost.
6. Total points earned by all participants. Record by their names on the Master Score sheet in their “race” (page 36).

### **Types of Questions to ask:**

- **About the story**
- **Spelling of a word**
- **Definition of a word**
- **Interpretation (by question with reference to a scripture. No need for exact reference)**

### **Scoring for “The Race” and “Family Challenge**

- **1 point for each question made**
- **1 point for each right answer**
- **1 point for using all Question Words**
- **Points on spinner added or subtracted (not subtracted for the young)**

### **Bonus Question Option:**

- **The questions are not about any story. There is a risk of losing points you spin on the spinner if answer is wrong (For young non-readers points are not subtracted)**
- **First tell if you want a question from the Bible or Book of Mormon. Using the Bonus Question Help sheets (pages )**
- **Then tell if you want an easy or hard question (1/2 points for easy, full points for the young).**
- **Then spin for points you will add, or subtract (not to go below 0) from your points only from this session.**

## **“FAMILY CHALLENGE”**

### **Full Directions**

**A Timer & Score Buddy (or put hatch marks on paper) & concordances are needed, 1 set of scripture labels & as many Question Word cards as people participating.**

1. The family chooses a day, time & one story from the Bible & one from the Book of Mormon for the participants to read during the week for the weekly “Family Challenge” (see Story Reference Guides,” pages 7-32). At the appointed day & time, family is gathered. They choose a Score Keeper (see page 6, #4). Each comes with scriptures, paper & pen. Divide the group in half & put a scripture label (page 42) in front of each half.
2. Young ones can choose a helper (not to give questions or answers, but to hint to them what questions to ask & what to answer). The child must be given first chance to answer a question immediately, before the rest of the family. The helper gets 1 point added to his total.
3. The Score Keeper puts as many Question Word cards as number of people - Who, What, When, Where, Why, How (see pages 39-41) face up in the middle. See pages 3 & 38 for scoring.
4. The group is timed 5 minutes to make as many questions as they can, each starting with a Question Word– Who, What, When, Where, Why, How & about the scripture on the label in front of them. Questions from their personal study can be used. It’s a good idea to keep them in a notebook for this purpose.
5. Score Keeper takes up all the Question Word cards & mixes. Then offers face down for each participant to draw one. He gets the last one.
6. Starting with the youngest, one by one, in turn, each gives a question starting with the Question Word card they chose. If they do not have a question they pass for that round. A round is completed after each participant asks a question. There are 6 rounds, one for each of the Question Words. After each round, the cards are collected and passed as for the first round.
7. After a question the one who first says, “I have it!” answers. There can be one challenge for the point (See page 6, #9). No points are subtracted from either.
8. After all rounds are completed each person has the option of answering a Bonus Question (see pages 23 & 34).
9. Points are totaled for each and recorded on the Master Score Sheet (see pages 2 & 34) toward their “Race.”

## **“TEAM CHALLENGE”**

**OVERVIEW** (See page 6 for complete directions)

(Post on poster, foam, chalk or dry erase board)

- 1. Read the stories from the Bible & Book of Mormon to the whole group**
- 2. Make 3 teams of not more than 12 each.**
- 3. Each team chooses a Captain & Score Keeper**
- 4. Make questions on your own each starting with a Question Word.**
- 5. Each team in turn asks questions to other teams.**
- 6. Anyone on another team can answer, “I have it!” but must first get O.K. of their team.**
- 7. There can be 1 challenge to an answer given by a team.**
- 8. After 6 rounds each team has the option of a Bonus Question.**
- 9. Total points of each team and post.**
- 10. If there are refreshments, the losing teams serve the winners first.**

### **Types of Questions to ask:**

- **About the story**
- **Spelling of a word**
- **Definition of a word**
- **Interpretation (by question with reference to a scripture)**

### **Scoring for “Team Challenge”:**

- **1 point for each question used**
- **1 point for each correct answer**
- **1 point for using all Question Words**
- **Bonus Question points from spinner**
- **1 Handicap point for each child under 11 who stay with their parent’s team to the end.**

### **Bonus Question Option** (Instead of posting, this can be explained when it is time.)

- The questions are not about any story. There is a risk of losing that number of points you spin on the spinner, not to go below zero, if answer is wrong. First tell if you want a question from the Bible or Book of Mormon.
- Then tell if you want an easy or hard question (1/2 points for easy).
- Only then do they spin the spinner for points you will add, or subtract (not to go below 0) from your points only from this session.

## **“TEAM CHALLENGE”**

### **Full Directions**

Supplies Needed: Bibles & Book of Mormons; Paper & Pens; Timer: Spinner (page 41); 3 Score Buddies (knitting counters); 3 sets of Bible & Book of Mormon Labels (page 40); 3 sets of Question Word cards (pages 37-39); & Bible & Book of Mormon Concordances

At the event, except about Bonus points, display page 5 info on foam, poster, chalk, or dry erase board large enough for 3 sections of information (“overview,” “types of questions to ask,” & “scoring”).

Make an announcement (page 41) for the monthly “Team Challenge” a couple of times, including the Story References from the Bible and Book of Mormon (pages 7-21 & 23-31) for participants to read at home, & other details.

#### **At the event:**

1. Have printed “overview,” “questions to ask” & “scoring” (page 5) where participants can easily read it.
2. Have the 2 stories, one from the Bible & one from the Book of Mormon to the whole group (can choose 2 people).
3. Make 3 teams of not more than 12 each, 11 years & older. If there are too many, form 3 teams in another room.
4. Each team chooses a Captain and a Score Keeper, who uses a “Score Buddy” or puts hatch marks on paper to keep score - on their honor.
5. Each Team is divided in half. Each half is given a Scripture Label (page 42) and a set of Question Word cards (pages 39-41).
6. Participants on all teams are given 5 minutes to make as many questions as they can on their own, each starting with the Question Words & from the Scripture Story for their half of the team.
7. After 5 minutes, everyone immediately stops writing (put pen down; Close books). Captains collect all Question Word cards, shuffles, & holds face down.
8. Each team Captain spins to be the first team, the other teams are 2 & 3 in turn. Team 1 Captain turns over & shows to their team the top Question Word card. Anyone on the team who has a question starting with that word can ask his question to the other teams. After all teams ask their first question this is round 1. There are 6 rounds (more or less according to majority decision) to complete the activity. Any participant on any team can say, “I have it!” to answer but must get full agreement of their team members first, and then the team gives their answer.
9. There can be one challenge for the point. The team with the right answer gets the point.
10. After questions are asked, each team can take the Bonus Question option (pg.5)
11. Total points for all teams (page 5) and post on chalk or dry erase board.
12. If there are refreshments the losing teams first serves the winning one.

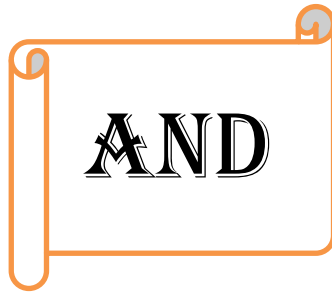
