Life of Jesus: Lesson 2 Baptism of Jesus

Materials: Laptop, Prayer list, movies on YouTube : 55 John Baptizes Jesus
Lemons, Q-tips, white paper and blow dryer.

YouTube song, There Were 12 Disciples
and snack.

1. Say opening prayer together; make sure to have them thank God for all their blessings and pray for others.
2. Ask if anyone has a testimony to share; they will stand up and give a testimony.
3. Inform students that we are going to continue with our unit about the Jesus. Today, we are going to continue to look at the life of Jesus. We are going to start with the baptism of Jesus and then learn about Jesus calling the 12 apostles/disciples.
4. Discuss the what we learned about what happened in the last lesson when Jesus was 12 years old and he stayed in Jerusalem in the temple after his parents and family went home to Nazareth. Jesus was already starting to do the will of his Father, God.
5. Watch the movie about the baptism of Jesus. Discuss that John was preparing people for Jesus and that many people thought that John was

the Christ, but John knew that Jesus was the Christ (Son of God) and that Jesus should baptize him, but Jesus told John that it was the right thing to do to baptize him. Jesus needed to set the example that we need to be baptized.

6. Discuss how John did not understand that he needed to baptize Jesus.

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7. Students will practice singing the song, "There Were 12 Disciples" we will be singing this song next week.
8. Students will have a snack, put money in collection, say closing prayer, and draw a prize from the cabinet.
