Prayer Unit: Being Thankful

11/11/18

Materials: Laptop, Scripture Lady Bible Prayer game, Prayer list on Word, snacks, dice.

- **1.** Say opening prayer together; make sure to have them say thank you those who participate.
- **2.** Inform students that we are going to continue with our unit about prayer.
- **3.** Discuss how they are already prayer warriors and we are going to learn how to become even better prayer warriors.
- **4.** Review and discuss each step of praying and why we need to say each part of the prayer.
 - 1. Say, "God or Heavenly Father".
 - 2. Thank God for blessings.
 - 3. Ask for needed blessings (God will give us strength and answers to make it through the bad/hard times).
 - 4. Say, "In Jesus Christ's Name Amen."

- 5. Have all these steps of prayer printed and put on poster board for the room so students can always see the steps as a reminder for the prayers.
- 6. Students and teachers will make a list of things and people to pray for on the computer and the teacher will have it up before we pray.
- 7. Inform students that we are going to do a lesson this week and next week on Thanksgiving and being thankful.
- 8. Read the Main Point and the Key Verse (from the King James Bible) of the "Thankful In All Things" by kidzlife lesson.
- Have the spider, grasshopper and lizard (or other small creatures) on a tray. These could be photocopied and laminated creatures. Do the Attention Grabber part of the lesson.
- 10. Now do the first paragraph under the Lesson: Read the verse 1

 Thessalonians 5:18 together.
- 11. Read and go over the Application part of the lesson.
- 12. If time, students may play the prayer game.
- 13. Students will have a snack

Students will put money in the collection, say closing prayer together and draw from the draw box.
