The Image of Daniel 2

Re Dan 2 "I know all about the Image that Daniel interpreted. The question is the little stone cut out without hands. I believe that referrers to Christ. I believe our church believes if I am right is the coming forth of the CHURCH OF CHRIST. I have heard another version that the Image is the image standing in the lasts days as the Revised Roman Empire and then When Christ Comes to earth He will destroy all the nations and as Daniel 9 (2-DLT) tells He will set up his kingdom which will never be destroyed or left to other people. If you have time how does our church stand today on Daniel."

Although I'm not aware of any official stand of the Church, (meaning in the Articles and Covenants or Referendums) our church membership would recognize this passage foretelling the restoration of Church of Christ in 1830 as you say. Even Protestant founders would say that the little stone that subsequently filled the whole earth was Christ's Church (kingdom). In recent times however, the prevailing new interpretation is that this Kingdom will not be set up until the "millennial kingdom" when Christ returns. The Image remains standing until Christ's government breaks it up and consumes these world governments. This is yet to take place. In this study, we will discuss your question "little stone cut out without hands" as well as this prophecy in greater detail.

Little Stone cut out Without Hands

Daniel 2: 28, 31-34, 44-45 But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets, and

maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days...Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof was terrible. This image's head was of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass, His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay. Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces. Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth. This is the dream; and we will tell the interpretation thereof before the king.... and in the days of these kings shall the God of



heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to

other people, but it shall **break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms**, and it shall stand for ever. <u>Forasmuch</u> (Lexicon: Strong's H3606 - kol (Aramaic – BECAUSE DLT) as thou sawest that the **stone was cut out of the mountain without hands**, and that it **brake in pieces the iron**, **the brass**, **the clay**, **the silver**, **and the gold**; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure.

<u>I Peter 2:7</u> Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the **stone which the builders disallowed**, the same is made the **Head of the corner**,

Verses 44 and 45, God gives the interpretation to what the stone is and what without hand means. I.E. God (Jesus Christ), and not man establishes His Kingdom (stone) which starts with the Head of the corner and increasing to fill the entire earth. I don't believe there's much of any dispute over that part. Let us now look at scriptures when God say he set sets up (establish Lexicon: Strong's H6966 - quwm (Aramaic) Kingdom.

The Kingdom of God, the Church, Established

Matthew 16: 18-19 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.



<u>Luke 22 : 29</u> And I **appoint unto you a kingdom**, as my Father hath appointed unto me;

Colossians 1:13 Who hath delivered <u>us</u> from the power of darkness, and hath translated <u>us</u> into the kingdom of his dear Son:

Hebrews 12: 28 Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:

<u>I Nephi 3 : 227-228</u> Nevertheless, I beheld that the **church of the Lamb**, which were the saints of God, were also upon all the face of the earth; And **their dominions** upon the face of the earth were small, because of the wickedness of the great whore which I saw.

Question for the group: If Jesus Christ set up His Kingdom on earth in the first century, why did He have to reestablish it again in the last day? (Daniel 2:28)



Latter Days- Christ establishes His Church among the Gentiles

<u>Daniel 2: 28, 31-34, 44-45</u> But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets, and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the <u>latter days</u>

I Nephi 4: 16,19,27,28 And now, the thing which our father meaneth concerning the grafting in

of the natural branches through the fullness of the gentiles, is, that in the latter days, when our seed shall have dwindled in unbelief, yea, for the space of many years and many generations, after that the Messiah hath manifested himself in body unto the children of men, then shall the fullness of the gospel of the Messiah come unto the Gentiles, and from the Gentiles unto the remnant of our seed;... Wherefore, they shall come to the knowledge of their Redeemer, and the very points of his doctrine, that they may know how to come unto him and be saved...And he meaneth that it shall come by



way of the Gentiles, that the Lord may shew his power unto the Gentiles, for the very cause that he shall be rejected of the Jews, or of the house of Israel: Wherefore, our father hath not spoken of our seed alone, but also of all the house of Israel, pointing to the covenant which should be fulfilled in the latter days;



Rom 11: 24-26 For if thou wert cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and wert graffed contrary to nature into a good olive tree: how much more shall these, which be the natural branches, be graffed into their own olive tree? For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that

blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:

III Nephi 10: 1 But if they will repent, and hearken unto my words, and harden not their hearts, I will establish my church among them, and they shall come in unto the covenant, and be numbered among this the remnant of Jacob, unto whom I have given this land for their inheritance, and they shall assist my people, the remnant of Jacob;

<u>Isaiah 29:14,17,23</u> Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvellous work among this people, even a marvellous work and a wonder: for the wisdom of their wise men shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent men shall be hid... Is it not yet a very little while, and

<u>I Nephi 3: 198-201</u> And the time cometh that he shall manifest himself unto all nations, both unto the Jews, and also unto the Gentiles; And the **last shall be first, and the first shall be last**. And it shall come to pass, that if the Gentiles shall hearken unto the Lamb of God in that day that he shall manifest himself unto them in word, and also in power, in very deed, unto the taking away of their stumblingblocks, if it so be that they harden not their hearts against the Lamb of God; and if it so be that they harden not their hearts against the Lamb of God, **they shall be numbered among the seed of thy father**; **(though Baptism DLT; see Gal 3:27-29)**

<u>Jacob 3: 125-127, 136-141</u>Wherefore, go to, and **call servants**, that we may labor diligently with



our mights in the vineyard, that we may prepare the way, that I may bring forth again the natural fruit, which natural fruit is good, and the most precious above all other fruit. Wherefore, let us go to, and labor with our mights, this last time; for behold the end draweth nigh: and this is for the last time that I shall prune my vineyard. Graft in the branches; begin at the last, that they may be first, and that the first may be last, and dig about the trees, both old and young, the first and the last, and the last and the first,

that all may be nourished once again for the **last time**... And the bad shall be cast away; yea, even out of all the land of my vineyard; for behold, only this once will **I prune my vineyard**... And it came to pass that the **Lord of the vineyard sent his servant**; and the **servant went and did as the Lord had commanded him**, **and brought other servants**; **and they were few.** And the Lord of the vineyard saith unto them, Go to, and labor in the vineyard, with your mights. For behold, this is the last time that I shall nourish my vineyard: for the end is nigh at hand, and the season speedily cometh; And if ye labor with your mights with me, ye shall have joy in the fruit which I shall lay up unto myself, against the time which will soon come. And it came to pass that the servants did go to it, and labor with their mights; and the Lord of the vineyard labored also with them; and they did obey the commandments of the Lord of the vineyard, in all things. And there began to be the natural fruit again in the vineyard; and the natural branches began to grow and thrive exceedingly;

<u>I Nephi 3: 190-191</u> And it came to pass that I beheld the remnant of the seed of my brethren, and also the book of the Lamb of God, which had proceeded forth from the mouth of the Jew, and I beheld that it came forth **from the Gentiles**, u**nto the remnant of the seed of my brethren**; And after it had come forth unto them, I beheld other books which came forth by the power of the Lamb, **from the gentiles** unto them, unto the **convincing of the Gentiles**, **and the remnant of the seed of my brethren**, **and also to the Jews**, which were scattered upon all the face of the earth, that the records of the prophets and of the twelve apostles of the Lamb are true.

Ill Nephi 9: 91-92 therefore, when these works, and the work which shall be wrought among you hereafter, shall **come forth from the gentiles** unto your seed, which shall dwindle in unbelief because of iniquity; For thus it behooveth the Father that it should **come forth from the gentiles**, that he may shew forth his power unto the Gentiles, for this cause, that the Gentiles, if they will not harden their hearts, **that they may repent and come unto me, and be baptized in my name**, and know of the **true points of my doctrine**, that they may be numbered among my people, O house of Israel:

<u>I Nephi 3 : 221-222</u> The **one is the church of the Lamb of God**, and the **other is the church of the devil;** Wherefore, whoso belongeth not to the **church of the Lamb** of God belongeth to that great church, which is the mother of abominations;


